



You can now receive treatment for a flare-up of mild plaque psoriasis at a local pharmacy



This means you don't need to see your doctor first.

Symptoms of mild plaque psoriasis

- Psoriasis is an auto-immune disease, causing inflamed skin and scaly, silvery plaques with a clear border.

Eligibility for pharmacy treatment

- If you are aged 18 years and older
- Currently have a flare-up of mild plaque psoriasis, on your knees, elbows and/or trunk
- Speak to a participating pharmacist to check if you can get a resupply of your cream or ointment.

Other treatments you can access under the Community Pharmacist Pilot

- treatment for shingles
- treatment for urinary tract infections
- resupply of an oral contraceptive pill
- travel health and vaccines.
