### Summary of MBS item numbers

Service type →	Maximisation of an individual patient's benefit from their medication regimen, and prevention of medication-related adverse events <sup>1</sup>	
Patient eligibility →	For patients living in the community, and at risk of medication-related adverse events <sup>1</sup>	For patients living in a Commonwealth-funded Residential Aged Care Facility, and at risk of medication-related adverse events <sup>1</sup>
Relevant MBS Item Number →	Domiciliary Medication Management Review (also known as Home Medicines Review or HMR) #900	Residential Medication Management Review #903
