

# 2006-09 Primary Health Multi-Purpose Report (V3)

Specification

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## Introduction

This data extract is designed to satisfy the Department of Human Services (DHS), Community & Women's Health (C&WH) program quarterly reporting requirements. However, there may be occasions when an additional report is required to report on data not collected by the main client management system eg. Fees collected may be managed by a separate software package.

## Purpose

The purpose of this document is to specify the requirements of the 2006-09 Primary Health Multi-Purpose Report to enable software providers to make necessary changes.

## Requirements

### Description

A transaction record is to be generated for each occurrence of a contact (individual or group contact) detailing the activity, the duration of the contact, any associated travel time and/or indirect time, whether a fee was collected and/or whether a DVA claim needs to be made, the socio-demographic characteristics of registered clients or whatever socio-demographic characteristics of casual clients that are available. The report also needs to collect any Indirect Service Time not associated with a group or individual contact.

File format for this report is comma separated (CSV).

## New Service Types

There are 3 new service types, Clinical Services & Training, Education & Training and Initial Needs Identification. Clinical Services & Training, Education & Training activities are funded under the Family Planning Program and are only funded to one agency (Family Planning Victoria). Initial Needs Identification (INI) is to be used to identify those activities related to the client's initial screening regardless of the practitioner performing the screening.

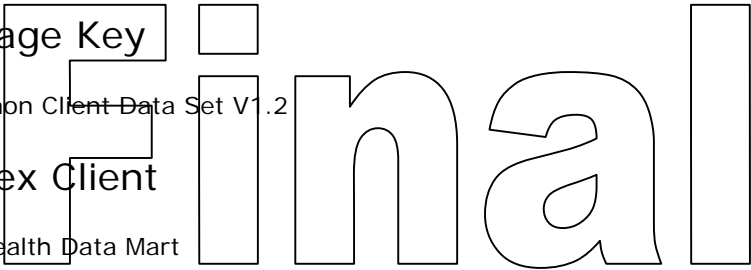
### Statistical Linkage Key
