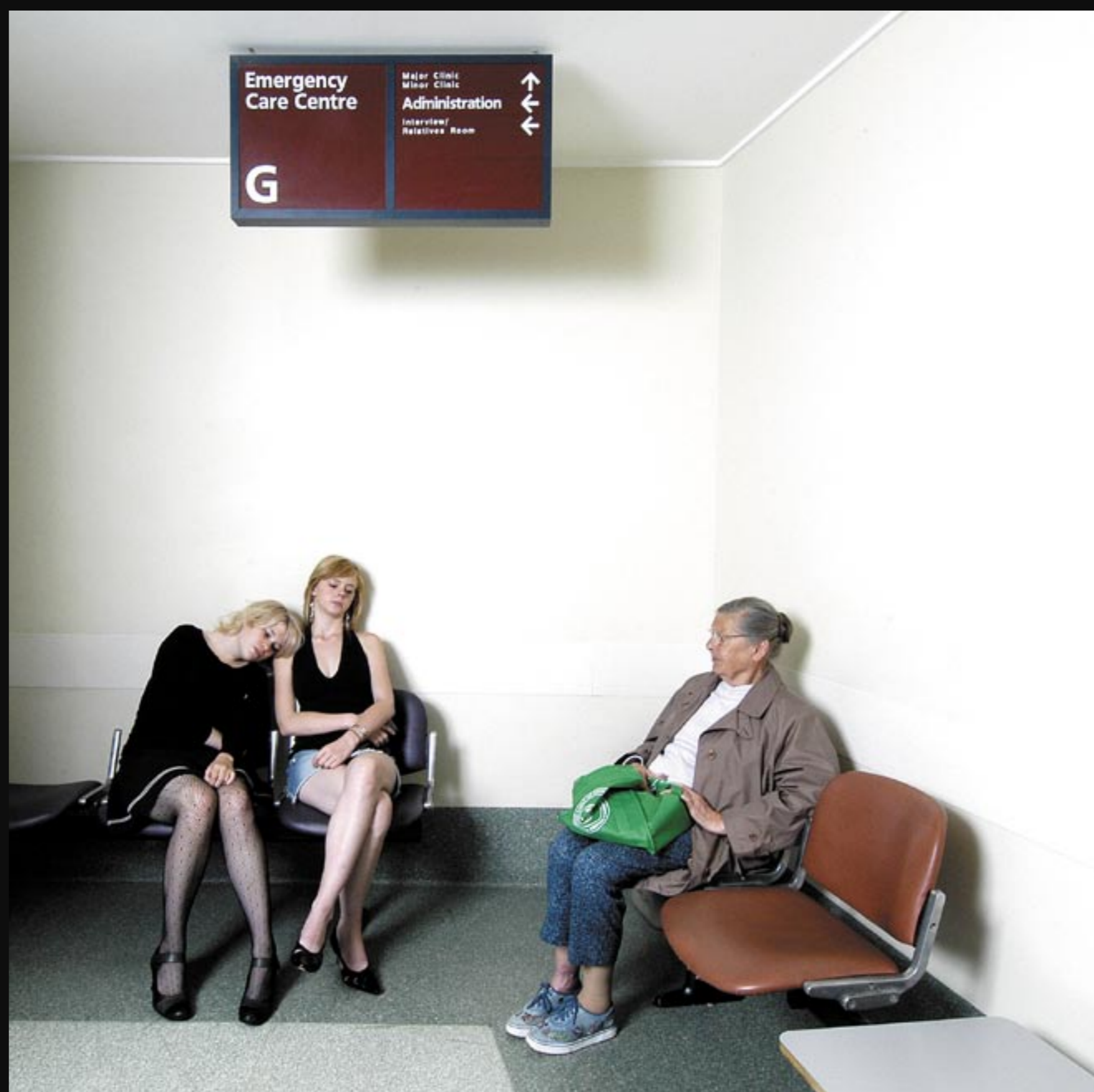




What will the night be like for your friends?



Using GHB is never safe

GHB has a delayed effect, overdose is common and you could die. Combined with alcohol or opiates, the risk is even greater.

OVERDOSE SIGNS:
Unconsciousness, confusion, nausea, slurred speech, vomiting, uncontrolled body movements, irregular breathing.

WHAT TO DO?
If someone cannot be woken or is incoherent seek assistance immediately from first aid, venue staff, or call 000 and ask for an ambulance.
