## 52.3 VAED Manual 12<sup>th</sup> Edition

When the VAED Manual was sent out in early October Sections 6 and 7 were not yet available. These have now been completed, and are being printed and will be sent to those on the original mailing list. This distribution will also include replacement pages for the Edit Matrix (Section 8), as the first version was corrupted, resulting in 258 appearing in many more instances than required.

Please note that this is the first printing of Section 7 since the *PRS/2 Manual, 9<sup>th</sup> Edition, July 1999*. The new version is significantly different to the previous version, and to draft copies handed out in PRS/2 Training sessions, and should be used instead of the previous instructions.

Because the manual was not complete, the first mail out was restricted to one copy per hospital, plus a limited number of other priority users. Now that all sections have been printed, a more extensive mail out will follow.

## 52.7 ICD-10-AM Library File Modifications

It has been necessary to modify age edits for the 2002-2003 ICD-10-AM Library File following a decision reached by the Coding Committee. The query relates to insertion of intrauterine devices (IUDs) for women over 60 years of age. Older women are now having IUDs inserted to treat menopausal and post-menopausal conditions. In ICD-10-AM Third Edition the 'contraceptive' term has been dropped from procedure block number 1260, which is now titled *Insertion or removal of intrauterine device*. Due to these changes, codes from this block are

now permitted to be assigned for women over 60 years of age. Full details of query #1854 and the decision reached by the Coding Committee will be published in the next issue of the ICD-10-AM Victorian Coding Newsletter.

As the treatment is for a menopausal condition, a diagnosis code from N95 *Menopausal and other perimenopausal disorders* should be assigned and not Z301 *Insertion of (intrauterine) contraceptive device*.

The high age trim point for Z301 *Insertion of (intrauterine) contraceptive device* has reverted to the previous high age trim point of 55 years.

Procedure codes from block 1260 *Insertion or removal of intrauterine device*: 3550300 *Insertion of intrauterine device [IUD]*, 3550600 *Replacement of intrauterine device [IUD]* and 3550602 *Removal of intrauterine device [IUD]* have been modified to allow this procedure to be performed for females 15 years of age and above. A warning edit will be triggered if the procedure is performed between the ages of 12-14 years and a rejection edit will be triggered if the procedure is performed under the age of 12 years.
