During the planning phase, 22 health issues have been identified and discussed by the Health Planning Advisory Panel. Four of these issues have been adopted as our priority health goals for immediate action. The Four Health Goals are 1) **Sense of Belonging and Connectedness**, 2) **Safe and Healthy Childhood**, 3) **Physical and Nutrition Wellbeing**, and 4) **Minimisation of Drug and Alcohol Misuse**.
