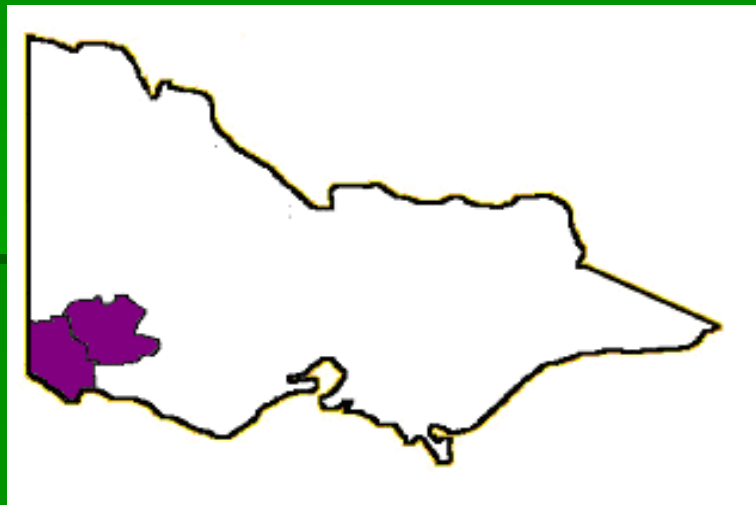

- presentations

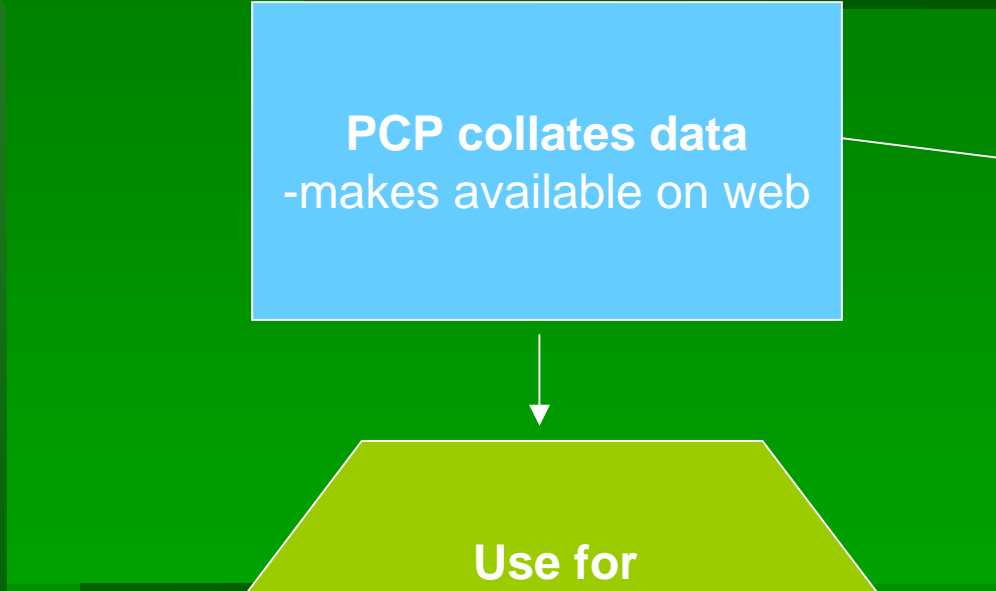
Use by community
