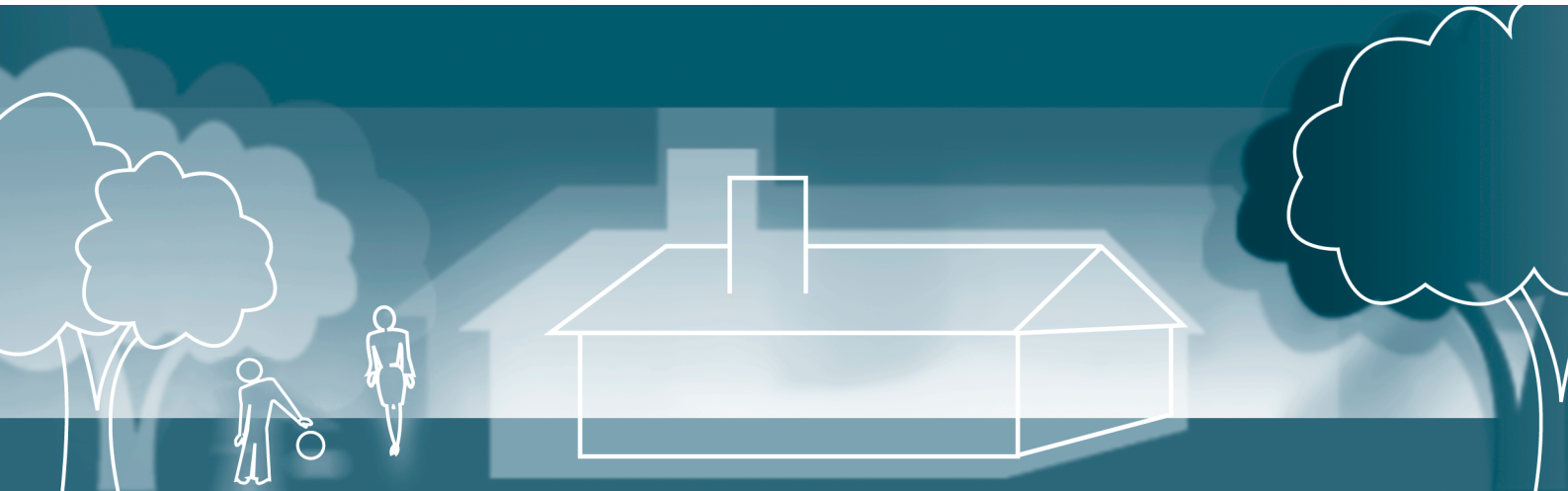
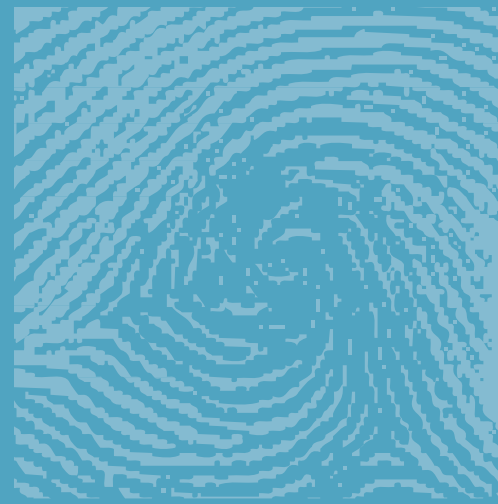


# Integrating Health in Local Government
