- Successful tender September 2004.



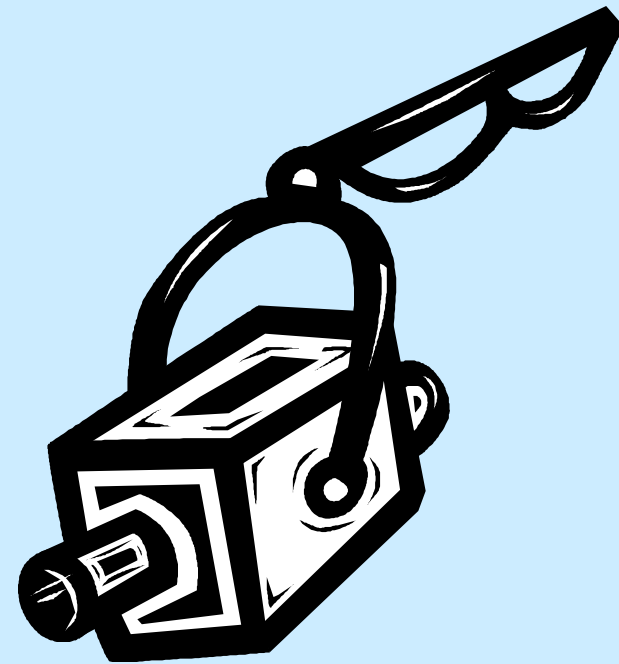
Security Review

 - Carparks / Vehicle Security



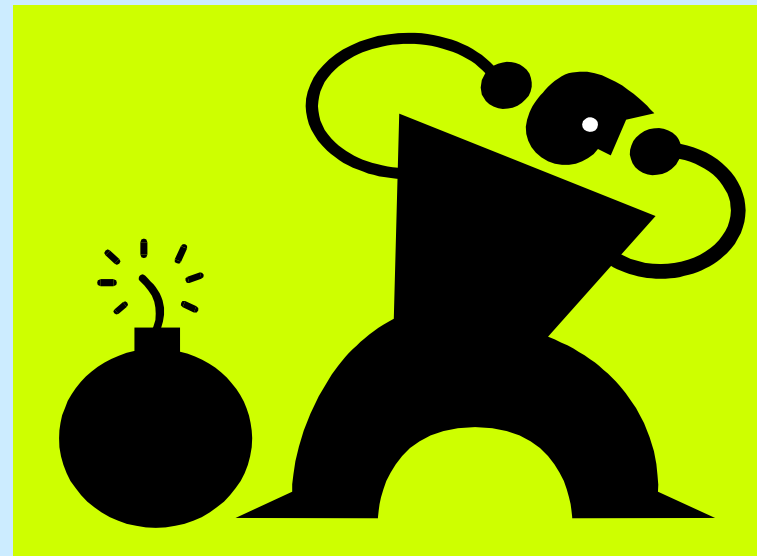
Security Review

- Site visits.
- Interview with key personnel:
 - Directors
 - Key Departments:
 - EMD
 - Psychiatry
 - Community Health
 - Outpatients
 - Safety
 - Security
 - General Staff
 - Key external providers
 - Day / Night



Security Review

- Report February 2005.
- Threat assessment / rating.



Security Review

- Common recommendations:
 - Procedures
 - Common philosophy
 - Electronics and physical security
 - Maintenance regime
 - Standardise electronic systems
 - Key system rationalised
 - Site specific recommendations e.g. duress, door systems, guard door system, surveillance upgrades

Security Review

- Presentation to Executive for acceptance.
- Implementation:
- Prioritisation of recommendation:
 - 6 month implementation
 - 12 month implementation
 - 24 month implementation
- Funding of projects.



Security Review

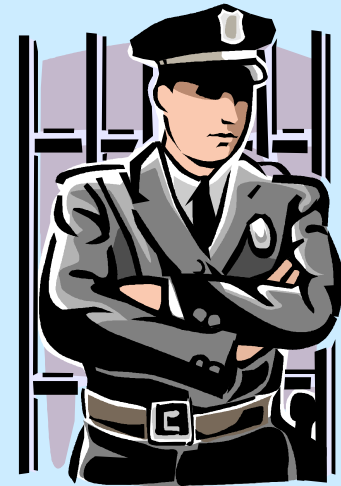
- Initial 6 months.
