Peak body – Palliative Care Victoria

Function in implementing the Strengthening Palliative Care Policy (SPCP)

Provide advocacy and leadership for the palliative care sector in Victoria in relation to the SPCP.

Role

Palliative Care Victoria Inc (Vic) is the peak body in Victoria representing palliative care providers and those with an interest in palliative care.

Responsibilities

- Provide advice and feedback to the department on issues relating to SPCP implementation in the palliative care sector.
- Provide opportunities for members to be informed about, and provide feedback on, SPCP implementation, evaluation and refresh.
- Promote collaboration among its members.
- Ensure that the diverse needs of members, members' clients and communities are represented in all decision making about palliative care.
- Provide forums for members, members' clients and communities.
- Establish, develop and maintain alliances, partnerships and networks relevant to palliative care.
- Influence palliative care policy.
- Inform and educate the community about palliative care.
