Call for nominations

Is something really good happening in your SRS, or another SAVVI SRS? Now is the time to tell everyone about it

SAVVI Recognition Awards are being held for the second time in 2010 – 2011. The Awards are **open to all SAVVI SRS** and will recognise good practice and innovation.

Nominations can be made in five different categories:

- Activities for residents
- Meals and nutrition for residents
- Involving residents and their families in having a say
- Working together with community services or other SRS
- Resident referral

Nominations can be made by SRS proprietors or staff members, for their own or another SAVVI SRS. Nominations can also be made by staff from other agencies who work with the SRS, but not by Department of Health personnel, Partnership Managers or Supporting Connections workers, Community Visitors or residents.

Nominations can be for one SRS or a group of SRS. An SRS can be nominated for more than one category. Winners will be announced at the SAVVI Statewide Forum in 2011. All accepted nominations will receive a certificate and the winner in each category will receive a plaque and a prize.
