IC4OP Policy

- Policy platforms:

2. Better understand the complexity of older peoples needs

 - **Principle 12:** All people across Victoria have access to Centred Promoting Health Independence. (CPHI)



Why Partnership?

 - Minimise duplication of effort
 - Mobilise talent, resources and approaches
 - Have impact on an issues that one organisation could not
 - Develop and demonstrate widespread support for action, issues, unmet needs
 - Recruitment
 - Resource utilisation in changing environment
