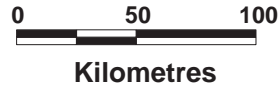
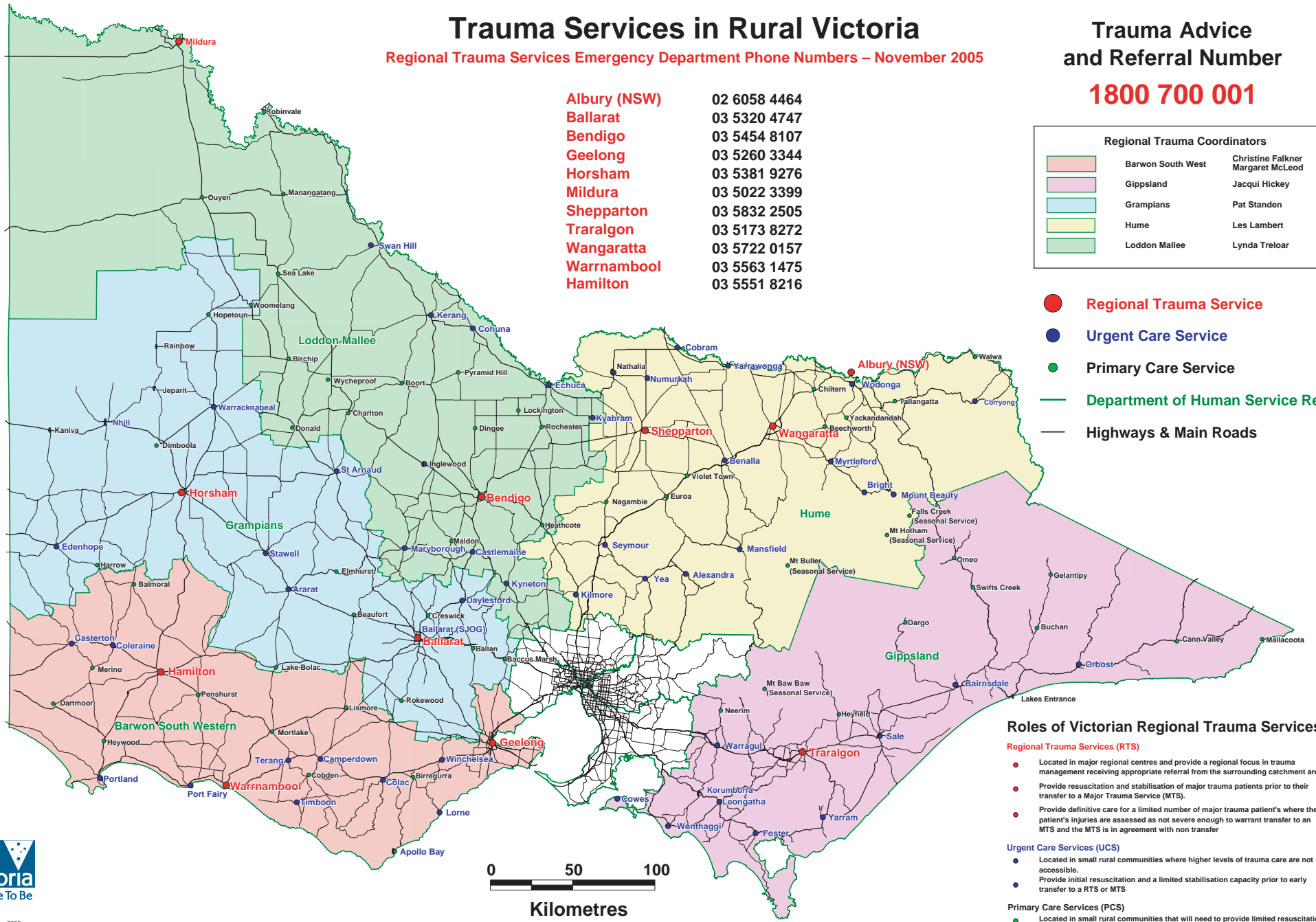

Roles of Victorian Regional Trauma Services

- Regional Trauma Services (RTS)**
- Located in major regional centres and provide a regional focus in trauma management receiving appropriate referral from the surrounding catchment area
 - Provide resuscitation and stabilisation of major trauma patients prior to their transfer to a Major Trauma Service (MTS).
 - Provide definitive care for a limited number of major trauma patients where the patient's injuries are assessed as not severe enough to warrant transfer to an MTS and the MTS is in agreement with non transfer
- Urgent Care Services (UCS)**
- Located in small rural communities where higher levels of trauma care are not accessible.
 - Provide initial resuscitation and a limited stabilisation capacity prior to early transfer to a RTS or MTS
- Primary Care Services (PCS)**
- Located in small rural communities that will need to provide limited resuscitation prior to early transfer to a RTS or MTS
