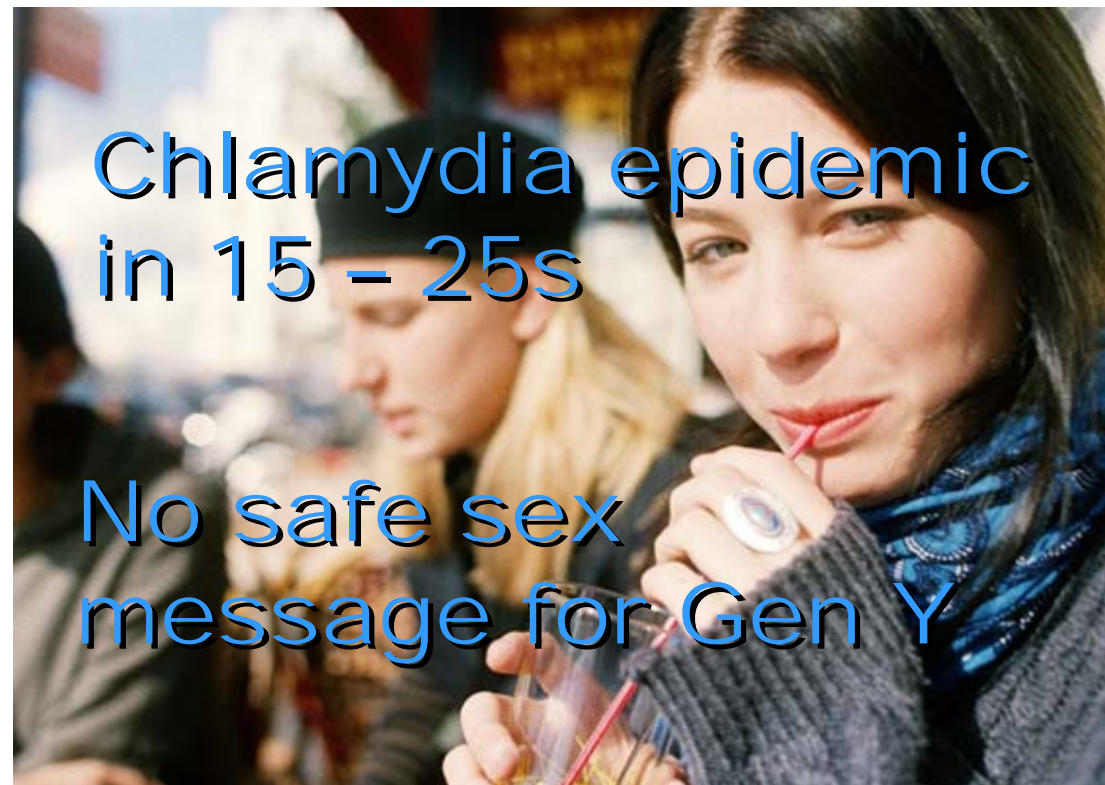

## Recommendations from the consultations

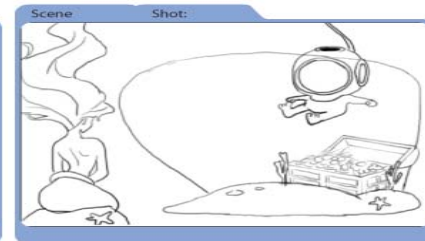
- Accessibility, Affordability, and Availability of condoms

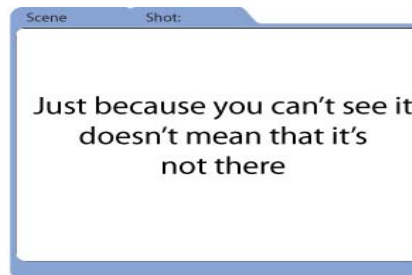


"Drop the bear" The Dom demands, punching the palm of his hand.

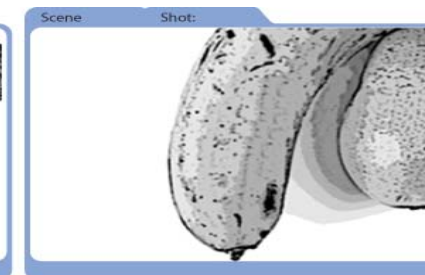


"Your not getting this one" The Dom continues. The Chlamydia clan leader looks at the sobbing koala then sends an evil look over at The Dom.
