


## R3 Lifeblood shipping configuration for Ambulance Victoria emergency use RBC

**2 units red blood cells (RBC). Validated transport time: 8 hours 25 minutes**





Total chilled ballast required = 14. If 4x RBC required, pack into 2x Lifeblood shippers.

Ballast MUST be chilled at 2-6°C for ≥24 hours prior to use.

Step	Legend	Name	Quantity	Note
1.		<b>Foil pouch</b>	<b>1</b>	Used to line box and contains all other items
2.		<b>Chilled ballast</b>	<b>8</b>	Inside foil pouch, 4 layers of 2
3.		<b>Plastic liner bag and 2x RBC</b>	<b>1</b>	Used to contain RBC (and temperature logger if used)
4.		<b>Chilled ballast</b>	<b>6</b>	Inside foil pouch, 3 layers of 2
5.	<b>Close foil pouch, seal shipper (including compatibility report if supplied) and attach completed label to top of shipper</b>
