Skin conditions

The medicines that will be available under the pilot for the treatment of skin conditions are yet to be advised. This schedule will be updated with this information prior to the provision of any skin services under the pilot.

Vaccinations

Vaccine costs are at the discretion of the pharmacy unless the patient is eligible for National Immunisation Program (NIP) or state-funded vaccines.

The below vaccines are authorised for administration under the pilot.

- Hepatitis A
- Hepatitis B
- Poliomyelitis
- Typhoid.

Additionally, the below vaccines can be administered under the pilot for the purpose of overseas travel.

- Influenza
- Diphtheria-tetanus-pertussis
- Human papillomavirus
- Measles
- Mumps
- Rubella
- Meningococcal ACWY
- Pneumococcal
- Herpes zoster/varicella zoster/shingles.

Combination vaccines may be used, for example, where a monovalent vaccine is not registered for use in Australia or where the combination vaccine meets the vaccination requirements of the individual and is recommended for use as per the Australian Immunisation Handbook. Pharmacist immunisers should ensure the relevant vaccine is in scope with relevant [Secretary Approvals](#).
