

Global case numbers of **measles** are rising.

Anyone planning to go overseas should make sure their routine vaccinations are up to date, including the measles-mumps-rubella (MMR) vaccine.

Travellers should ensure they have received 2 doses of the MMR vaccine before going overseas.

Infants as young as 6 months can receive a dose.

No Medicare card is required to get a free state-funded MMR vaccine.

If you were born overseas and travelling to visit family, talk to them about your own vaccination status.
