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Patient born during or after 1966 without two doses Fever & rash?

OR

Fever + red eyes, cough or runny nose?

Suspect measles especially in people who are:

- returned travellers
- contact of a measles case
- unimmunised

Actions for healthcare providers:

- On arrival give the patient a face mask to wear and place them in a single room

 preferably with negative pressure, or a room with a closed door.
- 2. Test:
 - Nasopharyngeal aspirate or throat swab +/- first catch urine for PCR
 - Blood for measles serology (IgM and IgG)
 - Mark request as urgent.

- 3. Isolate
 - If admitted to hospital keep patient in a negative pressure room and notify the Infection Prevention and Control Team
 - If patient is sent home advise them to isolate at home and avoid having visitors while awaiting results.
- **4. Notify** the Department of Health **immediately** for any suspected case on 1300 651 160.
