

# Summary – licence scenarios and how to apply for a 1080 licence

**Table: Licence scenarios and how to apply for a licence to manufacture and sell or supply, or sell or supply 1080 pest animal baits.**

New licence to sell or supply by wholesale <b>APVMA-registered 1080 pest animal baits</b> and/or perishable <b>1080 pest animal baits prepared under APVMA permit.</b></p> <p>Complete the forms for a Licence to Sell or Supply by Wholesale.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Complete an application form for the licence.</li> <li>Complete an application to nominate a responsible person.</li> <li>Complete and maintain a Poisons Control Plan.</li> <li>Pay the application fee.</li> </ul> <p>DH inspection of manufacturing premises will be required.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Nil</li> </ul>
<p>4. Applicants in category (1) or (7) for a licence to manufacture and sell or supply perishable <b>1080 pest animal baits prepared under APVMA permit</b> who also wish to commence wholesale supply of <b>APVMA registered 1080 pest animal baits</b>, will need to incorporate descriptions of this activity within the relevant sections of the 1080 Poisons Control Plan submitted in the application.</p>	<p>Concurrent with applications in categories (1) and (7)</p>	<p>Consistent with applications in categories (1) and (7)</p>

Existing holders of a licence Existing licence holders who have a licence to manufacture and sell or supply <b>APVMA-registered 1080 pest animal baits</b> by wholesale, who wish to manufacture perishable <b>1080 pest animal baits prepared under APVMA permit</b>.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Complete the 1080 Application Form.</li> <li>• Complete 1080 Responsible Person Form.</li> <li>• Complete and maintain 1080 Poisons Control Plan.</li> <li>• Pay the amendment fee where inspection is required.</li> </ul> <p>DH inspection of manufacturing premises will be required before the 1080 Poisons Control Plan is approved and the licence amended.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Be a manufacturer of APVMA registered 1080 aqueous solution used to prepare the 1080 pest animal baits; or</li> <li>• Have a DPI Commercial Operator Licence with Vermin destroyer endorsement; and have completed 1080 manufacturer training and Agsafe on-line training.</li> </ul>
<p>6. Existing licence holders who have a licence to manufacture and sell or supply Schedule 7 poisons by wholesale who wish to commence manufacture of <b>APVMA-registered 1080 pest animal baits</b>, will need to consider if the existing Responsible Person and Poisons Control Plan are adequate and if not:</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Complete a new application to nominate a responsible person.</li> <li>• Revise the existing Poisons Control Plan.</li> <li>• Pay the amendment fee where inspection is required.</li> </ul> <p>DH inspection of manufacturing premises will be required before the revised Poisons Control Plan is approved and the licence amended.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Nil</li> </ul>
<p>7. Existing licence holders who have a licence to manufacture and sell or supply Schedule 7 poisons by wholesale, who wish to commence manufacture of perishable <b>1080 pest animal baits prepared under APVMA permit</b>.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Complete the 1080 Application form.</li> <li>• Complete the 1080 Responsible Person form.</li> <li>• Complete and maintain a 1080 Poisons Control Plan.</li> <li>• Pay the application fee.</li> </ul> <p>DH will need to inspect your premises before issuing an amended licence.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Be a manufacturer of APVMA registered 1080 aqueous solution used to prepare the 1080 pest animal baits; or</li> <li>• Have a DPI Commercial Operator Licence with Vermin destroyer endorsement; and have completed 1080 manufacturer training and Agsafe on-line training.</li> </ul>

Existing licence holders who have a wholesale licence to sell or supply Schedule 7 poisons, who wish to include the wholesale of <b>APVMA registered 1080 pest animal baits</b> or perishable <b>1080 pest animal baits prepared under APVMA permit</b>, will need to consider if the existing Responsible Person and Poisons Control Plan are adequate and if not:</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Complete a new application to nominate a responsible person</li> <li>• Revise the existing Poisons Control Plan.</li> <li>• Pay the amendment fee where an inspection is required.</li> </ul> <p>DH inspection of wholesaling premises will be required before issuing an amended licence.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Nil</li> </ul>
