

Activity to date

- 1347 patients enrolled
- 1400 WIES utilised (650 remaining)







Our Cohort

- 1. Very unwell and medically complex. Have long and expensive medical admissions. Older well people who become acutely unwell or older people who are pre-palliative. High WIES users, low admissions
- 2. Older with chronic disease or younger with multiple co-morbidities. Require support and integrated care to be in the community. Can easily utilise 2.2 WIES, low admissions
- Younger +/- chronic disease with psychosocial factors and unhealthy lifestyles as reasons for admissions. High admission rates (SSU) and low WIES utilisation
- 4. Young with mental health, D & A, complex psychosocial factors. Known to many services, utilise ED and SSU. May have FP plan. High admission rates (SSU) and low WIES utilisation




